7 Cycle Tracks- Cllrs feel that if all footways were widen and maintained as they should be this would be suitable for needs

8 A rumoured change of use at Southfields, Cllr Thurlow to clarify with R.D.C

9 Local government changes-emails from R.D.C. and N.Y.C.C have been viewed by councillors regarding a super council for North Yorkshire. Cllrs feel that it could widen the gap between county and parish.
