The Minutes of the Meeting of Beadlam Parish Council held on Monday 4th April 2022, in Nawton Memorial Hall at 7.30pm.

Matters arising –

1. Planning Applications- A revised plan for 2 Birklands has been submitted 22/00010/HOUSE. Cllrs agreed although still very big it looked a lot better and was more in keeping with the street
2. Trees, Gale Lane. Cllrs had received requested information on a residents request to plant 4 oak trees on the verge below Ryedale School. Cllrs thought that oak trees were not suitable for the site as they are stand -alone trees which need space
3. Jubilee-The two parish councils are purchasing a medal for each child under the age of 12 to celebrate the jubilee. The bunting has been recycled for use in the village and plans for the Local History Display in the Hall seems to be going well.
4. Parish Council Nominations –All have been accepted by R.D.C

- 1 Ryedale School Planning- A resident of Birklands is in correspondence with N.Y.C.C
- 2 Grant towards obtaining a defib. There is one outside the Rose and Crown, Cllrs not sure if or where another could go
- 3 Parish Trees for Felling. Mr Brian Simpson had been in contact with concerns over the state of some trees on parish land. They are due to be felled, he would do the work and M.Thurlow would again log them for the over 65's in the village. For storage of wood whilst work completed Cllr Barker suggested Ian Belt who has the farm buildings and yard
