R.D.C. Foot path A170/Hillcrest/Fusion Spice. Streetscene had cleared the path of leaves mud and road dirt after a request from cllrs.

R.D.C. Planning Application 22/00010/HOUSE 2 Birklands Cllrs agreed it seemed an overdevelopment of site and altered the streetscene of Birklands, something Ryedale District refused an application at 1 Birklands for.

R.D.C. Planning Application 21/01640/FUL Canadian Fields. As a neighbouring parish Cllrs were concerned that development was too big, traffic along Gale Lane a major issue and light pollution from the site.

Traffic and light pollution had already been raised with the planning at Ryedale School.
